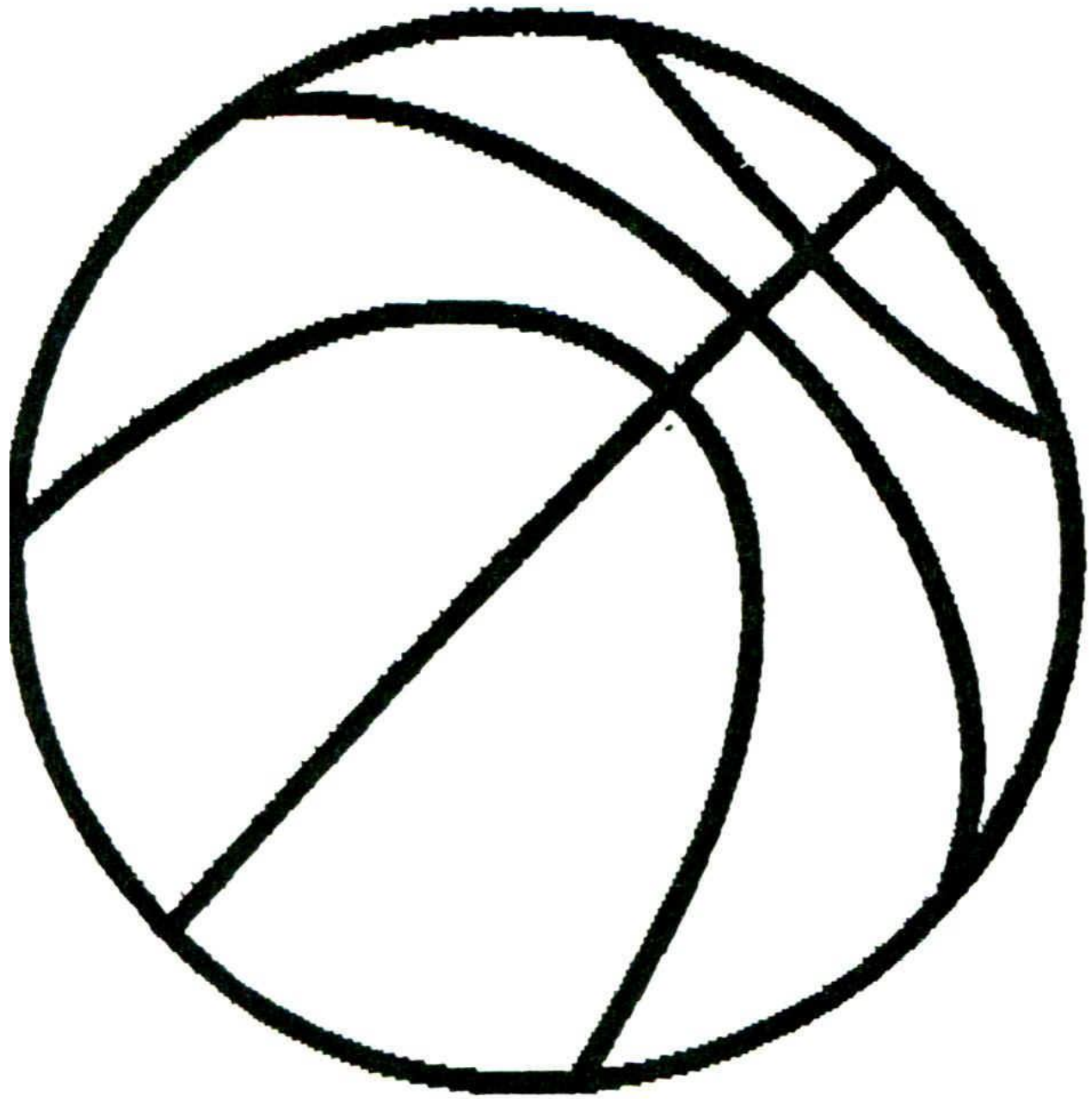

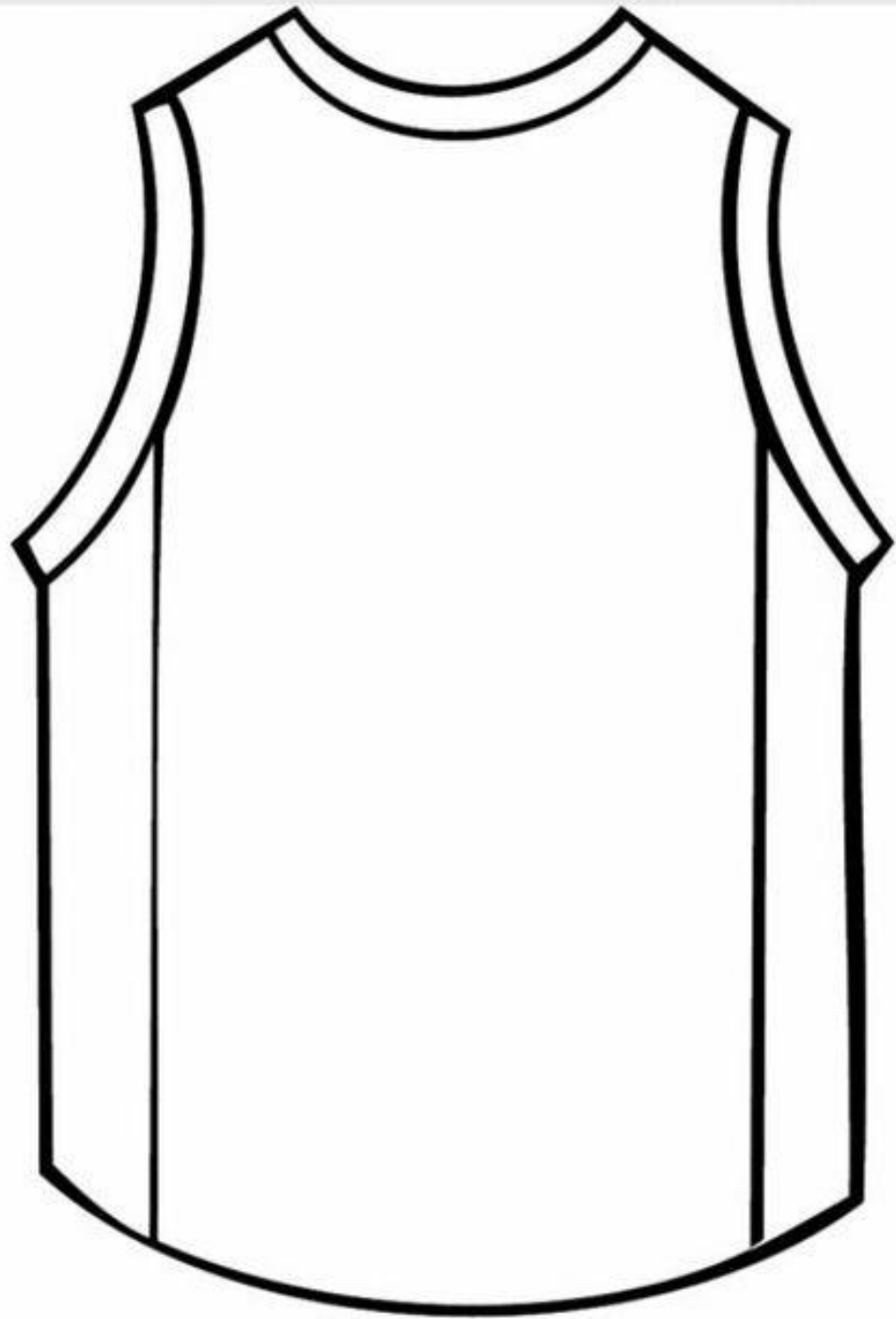
Elementary Jersey and Basketball Decorating Contest
